ShenanArts seeks to foster an environment of communication, safety, and respect, to ensure the health, safety, and well-being of all of our volunteers. We hope the following disclosures help you make an informed choice should you be offered a role in this production.

PRODUCTION SCHEDULE

First day of rehearsal: Friday, May 24 (depending on availability of cast)

Typical range of rehearsal hours: 6:30PM to 9:30PM on week nights; 2:00PM to 6:00PM on weekends

Typical rehearsal days: In May and June, Saturday and Sunday rehearsals for vocals and dance; performers should also expect to be called once or twice a week on weeknights for scene work. In July, once we begin single act and full show run-throughs, rehearsals will likely occur three weeknights plus Sundays, depending on cast availability. Nobody will be called more than four rehearsals per week until tech week.

Technical rehearsals begin: Sunday, July 28 – double tech: Cue-to-Cue from 1:00PM to 5:00PM, 1 hr break for dinner, technical run through (including costumes, microphones, hair and makeup) from 6:00PM to 9:30PM.

Monday, July 29: Full tech run, 6:00PM call*, start by 7:30PM Tuesday, July 30: Full tech run, 6:00PM call*, start by 7:15PM Wednesday, July 31: Full tech run, 6:00PM call*, start by 7:00PM

Thursday, August 1: Dark Day - no rehearsal (unless we REALLY NEED it)

Performances begin: Friday, August 2

Performances end: Sunday, August 11

Days/times of all planned performances: 8/2/24, 8/3/24, 8/9/24, 8/10/24 – 7:00PM (call* by 6:00PM); 8/4/24, 8/11/24 – 3:00PM (call* by 2:00PM).

*Call times may vary for some characters depending on makeup/costuming/fight choreography requirements. Please note any potential conflicts with an earlier call time on performance and tech rehearsal dates.
